Faculty members in LLED engage in research collaborations with educational communities at the local, national, and international levels to advance theoretical understandings, practical knowledge, and the study of the teaching and learning of language, literacy, literature, drama/theatre and culture in their broadest sense. The department contributes to the Faculty's teacher education program and offers magistral and doctoral programs in Literacy Education, Teaching English as a Second Language, and Modern Language Education, and a diploma program in Teacher Librarianship. We are currently seeking applications for Department Head from individuals with an international reputation and a strong record of research and publication in Language and Literacy Education and related fields. Applicants should have interests in key areas of the Department and a desire to interact with colleagues from different fields of study within the Department, Faculty of Education, UBC, and the wider community.

Applicants should show evidence of successful administrative experience and strategic planning, including budgets, along with demonstrated leadership, communication, team-building, mentoring, problem-solving and interpersonal skills. The successful applicant will have a distinguished record of academic accomplishments consistent with a Professor with tenure in UBC.

The Headship appointment is for a period of up to 5 years, with the potential for renewal of another 5-year term. It is expected that the successful candidate will qualify for and be offered a separate academic appointment at the rank of Professor with tenure. The appointment is effective July 1, 2014 or a date agreed upon by the University and the successful applicant, and subject to final budgetary approval. Salary is commensurate with qualifications and experience.
