

2016 Ritsumeikan Visiting Professorship(VISI Professor)

The UBC Ritsumeikan Academic Exchange Programme (http://rits.ubc.ca/) is seeking applications from members of The Faculty of Arts or Faculty of Education for the 2016 Visiting Professorship at Ritsumeikan University in Kyoto, Japan.

Under this agreement a <u>tenured or tenure track faculty member</u> has an opportunity to conduct research while making a teaching contribution at Ritsumeikan University for one academic semester. Applicants' teaching field(s) must match those offered by Ritsumeikan. Please check the Ritsumeikan English Language website to determine their current programs: http://www.ritsumei.ac.jp/eng/

Teaching assignments at Ritsumeikan for the 2015 fall semester have already been determined. Interested applicants would be applying for the spring or fall semester for 2016. The VISI Professor will be expected to remain in Japan until the grades for his/her course are submitted.

Spring Semester (approximate dates)

Semester begins: April 1, 2016 Last day of class: July 20, 2016

Exam period: July 23 - August 2, 2016

Fall Semester (approximate dates)

Semester begins: September 26, 2016 Last day of class: January 21, 2017

Exam period: January 23 - February 21, 2017

Ritsumeikan University provides single accommodation for the VISI Professor although it may be possible to arrange suitable accommodation for a family if advance notice is given. The Faculty of Arts or Faculty of Education provides travel expenses to a maximum of \$5000. There is no additional stipend or teaching buyout provided by UBC.

The successful applicant will:

- 1. Demonstrate the value of his/her participation in the program to their academic career/the Faculty/university
- 2. Meet the teaching, research, and collegial needs of Ritsumeikan
- **3**. Have a strong record of teaching excellence
- **4.** Have a demonstrated potential for intellectual engagement with colleagues at Ritsumeikan University.
