LLED is operating two non-credit courses in the Vancouver Summer Program: two sections each of Applied Linguistics for Teachers, and of Introduction to Teaching English as a Second Language (brief descriptions can be found here: <http://pdce.educ.ubc.ca/vancouver-summer-program/> click on “Education Package B”). These courses are based on LLED 489 and LLED 478, but are not the same, and will require course development in collaboration with other LLED VSP instructors (and responsible LLED faculty) in addition to teaching.

Applicants must have a minimum of a recognized master's degree in TESL, English language education, or related field, with relevant academic expertise in applied linguistics and teaching English as an additional/second language, in addition to at least 3 years of experience teaching English as an additional/second language in Canadian schools. Experience in TESL teacher education is desired. Duties include collaborating with the other LLED VSP instructors in developing and teaching the courses, holding regular office hours, marking assignments, assigning grades.
