## UBC-Ritsumeikan Academic Exchange Programs 12-Month-Lecturer

The Department of Language and Literacy Education, Faculty of Education, UBC, invites applications for a one-year full-time Lecturer position without review (non-tenure track). The successful applicant is expected to teach courses offered through the UBC-Ritsumeikan Programs: the UBC-Ritsumeikan Academic Exchange Program and the UBC-Ritsumeikan Global Citizenship Program. For more information please visit: <http://www.rits.ubc.ca/programs/index.html>. The successful applicant will be expected to carry an annual teaching load of 30 credits. The incumbent of this position will work closely on academic planning activities with the UBC-Ritsumeikan Programs Academic Director and other program members.

Applicants will have an earned doctoral degree in Teaching English as a second language, applied linguistics, second language education, or equivalent, and a strong interest in English for Academic Purposes. Preference will be given to applicants that have experience teaching international /ESL university students, and who demonstrate familiarity with content-based instruction. Evidence of instructional leadership activities (curriculum development and planning, conference presentations and publications related to Language Education) as well as strong collaborative skills and experience will be considered an asset.

The position is expected to commence **August 1, 2013**. The appointment will be made at the 12 Month Lecturer level, with the possibility of renewal on a yearly basis subject to availability of funds, satisfactory performance and in accordance with University policies. Salary is commensurate with qualification and experience.

The position is subject to final budgetary approval.

Applications should include a letter indicating clearly the position being sought and outlining potential contributions to the Department/UBC-Ritsumeikan Academic Exchange Programs, curriculum vitae, evidence of teaching excellence, a sample of scholarly work, and the names of three references. The quality of teaching will be assessed as part of the selection process.
